About Value-returning Functions

Problem statement. Write a value-returning function named `zero`, with no parameters, that returns the `int` value 0.

Solution.

```
int zero()
{
    int result = 0;
    return result;
}
```

Problem statement. Write a value-returning function named `doubleIt`, with one `int` parameter, that returns two times the parameter's value.

Solution.

```
int doubleIt(int number)
{
    int result = 0;
    result = 2 * number;
    return result;
}
```

Problem statement. Write a value-returning function named `bigger`, with two `int` parameters and returns the larger of the two parameters (and either one if they are the same).

Solution.

```
int bigger(int a, int b)
{
    int result = a;
    if (b > a) result = b;
    return result;
}
```
