Problem statement. Write a single declaration statement that creates an uninitialized boolean variable named result.

Solution.

```
boolean result;
```

Problem statement. Write a single declaration statement that creates a boolean variable named found and initializes it to false.

Solution.

```
boolean result = false;
```

Problem statement. Write a value-returning function named itsTrue, with no parameters, that returns the boolean value true.

Solution.

```
static boolean itsTrue()
{
    boolean result = true;
    return result;
}
```

Problem statement. Write a code block to test a boolean variable named b, and output "It's true!" to the console screen if b's value is true.

Solution.

```
if (b) System.out.println("It's true!");
```

Problem statement. Write a code block to test a boolean variable named b, and output "It's false!" to the console screen if b's value is false.

Solution.

if (!b) System.out.println("It's false!");
