## Programming Exercise 8.4

## Password-protected Mortgage Calculator, v.2.0

**Purpose**. Learn how to use a function to enhance a program, by adding one to an existing program.

**Requirements**. Rewrite Exercise 8.3's <code>secureMortgageCalculator1.py</code> program, naming the new program <code>secureMortgageCalculator2.py</code>. Limit the user to 3 incorrect password entries. Exit the program if the correct password is not entered after 3 tries. Think about it -- the function will have to tell main that either a valid password got entered in 3 tries, or not. You decide on the exact wording of the prompts and the return type for the function.

**Program I/O.** <u>Input</u>: a password from the console keyboard, and then two mortgage calculation inputs. Output: An "invalid" message for each incorrect password entry, then the mortgage calculation output, unless 3 invalid passwords were entered.

**Examples.** Here's what the output should look like, with user input in blue:

Enter the password: 123

INVALID

Enter the password: ABC

INVALID

Enter the password: xyz123

INVALID
